Wirth, 1982 Fire was an African American literary magazine published in New York City in 1926 during the Harlem Renaissance The publication was started by Wallace Thurman Zora Neale Hurston Aaron Douglas John P Davis Richard Bruce Nugent Gwendolyn Bennett Lewis Grandison Alexander Countee Cullen and Langston Hughes After it published one issue its quarters burned down and the magazine ended Fire was conceived to express the African American experience during the Harlem Renaissance in a modern and realistic fashion using literature as a vehicle of enlightenment The magazine s founders wanted to express the changing attitudes of younger African Americans In Fire they explored controversial issues in the Black community such as homosexuality bisexuality interracial relationships promiscuity prostitution and color prejudice Wikipedia viewed September 13 2021 Fire!!
